The Cookery Contest is conducted for the Queensland Country Women's Association to raise funds for QCWA Projects, by the sale of entries.

All entries at Division level become the property of QCWA State Cookery Committee and must be sold to raise funds for the Cookery Committee. Refer to *State By-Laws*.

Sale prices are to be determined by the Cookery Convenor or Cookery Chairman at each level ie Branch, Division and State. A list of recommended sale prices is attached.

State Prizes: Perpetual Trophies for the winning competitor for Any Other Cake not mentioned on the schedule and Any Other Slice not mentioned on the schedule. Name of cake or slice and recipe to be included with entry (at each level with item). Donated by Jan Anderson.

Division Prizes: Perpetual Trophy (not Pro-rata) for the Division raising the most money. Donated by Mrs M. Wilke.

A pro-rata prize for the Division raising most money from contests. Donated By Sunnybank Coopers Plains Branch.

To be paid by State Committee to all Division place getters.

STATE COOKERY RULES

All entries become the property of QCWA State Cookery Committee at point of entry into Division and State competition.

Clearly mark all entries with initial, name and Branch at Division Level.

All Entries must have a list of Ingredients included at all Levels.

All entries must be at least three days old on day of the State Finals Competition.

It is now optional for the Branches to have a Branch Competition or enter straight to the Division.

Everybody is able to enter in the Division Competition. No limit to how many from a Branch can enter in each Class. Branches must nominate the entrants to the Division Convenor 2 weeks before the Division Competition to let the Division organise their judges and space needed.

The 1st place entry from Division is eligible to compete at the State finals if applicable.

A competitor entering in more than one Division in any section and becoming a prize winner in this section must notify the Convenors of **both** Divisions as to which Division she will represent at State level. The Convenors will allow the second place winner of the other Division the opportunity to compete at State level.

NO ENTRY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - COOKERY COMPETITION

The Cookery Contest is conducted for the Queensland Country Women's Association to raise funds for QCWA Projects.

The Cookery Contest is not restricted to members of the Association, but open to any persons residing in Queensland and to all QCWA members regardless of place of residence.

Guide for Cookery Convenors:

At Division level, additional classes, other than those on this printed schedule may be added if desired and additional prizes awarded locally, but prize-winners in such classes will not compete in the State Finals of the competition.

Each Branch needs to send in their nominated entries to the Division Convenor, 2 weeks before the Division Competition. No limit to how many can entries each class from a Branch. 1 entry per person to each class.

- Entrants name is not to appear on side or lid of jar.
- Please use cleanskin jars *ie* no embossed names *eg* Cottee's to be on jars.
- It is preferred that a plain lid with no writing/advertising be used.
