QCWA STATE SEWING SCHEDULE

Adult Section

1. Budget Garment – fabric and notions to the value of \$35, copy of receipts to be included.
2. Daywear Garment or outfit – Please see definition.
3. Smart Casual garment or outfit. - Please see definition.
4. Centenary Class – Ladies Garment made from a vintage pattern – design to be over 25 years old – copy of pattern envelope or magazine to be included.
5. Product of the Year – Dragonfruit – child's outfit - black and white spot with bright pink trim.
6. Beginner – Garment for adult or child - a person just starting to learn to sew **NOT** a person returning to sewing after an absence. Must contain at least 2 of the following – zip, buttonholes & buttons, top stitching, gathers, darts or tucks.

Children's Sections

- 7a. Outfit suitable for a child – birth to 2 years
- 7b. Outfit suitable for a child – 3 years to 6 years
- 7c. Outfit suitable for a child – 7 years to 10 years

Please read the rules, helpful hints and guidelines prior to commencing your entry.

Rules

1. The contest is restricted to Members of the Association and they may not be a professional dressmaker.
2. The contest is held at Division, Region and State Level.
3. The winning garment/outfit in each section will progress to the next level.
4. Entry fee is \$1.00 per entry forwarded to Division Treasurer who then sends it to the State Dressmaking Treasurer.
5. Garment/outfit not be modelled by the maker.
6. Entries for judging in State Finals are to be sent to the State Dressmaking Chairman as soon as possible after the Region conference and before the end of September. All judging will be done prior to Conference.
7. A garment/outfit is an article of clothing which can be worn alone. A vest or skirt has insufficient sewing and dressmaking skills.
8. Children's Sections – the outfits can be suitable for a boys or girls.
9. An entry label is to be attached to each garment. The label can be found with the guidelines.
10. Entries are to be delivered in a garment bag with entrant's details clearly marked on the outside.

Definitions

Day wear – any garment that you would wear to a meeting, outdoor wedding or the races

Smart Casual wear – any garment that you would wear on holiday, a lunch date, shopping

Vintage pattern – any pattern over 25 years, can be original, a re-release from the pattern company or a pattern from a magazine such as "Home Journal".
