



## **GENERAL GUIDELINES QCWA MEMBER'S COMPETITIONS**

### **Project Book**

- Not more than 40 leaves i.e. 80 pages, plus cover (including Contents and Bibliography pages).
- Size A4-A3
- Country map, either hand drawn or traced, text to be handwritten and original work of member/members. Plagiarism is not acceptable.

### **Scrap Book**

- not more than 32 leaves i.e. 64 pages, plus cover (Contents and Bibliography pages not to be included)
- Scrap book contains pictures, photographs, photocopies or digital printouts of pictures and captions.
- Captions are limited to 25 words or less and may be handwritten, typed, or be included in cut out of pictures.

N.B. Project Book and Scrap Book covers may be creative, with decorations to be firmly attached. Each entry to be forwarded for next level of judging in a soft fabric bag, with entrant's Name, Branch and Division placed in a small envelope, glued securely inside the back cover.

### **Computer-Generated Project Book**

- Not more than 40 leaves i.e. 80 pages, plus cover (including Contents and Bibliography pages).
- Size A4-A3
- Cover, text and pictures, including Country map must be computer generated.
- Text must be original work of the member/members. Plagiarism is not acceptable.

N.B. Judging sheets are to be replaced with a new Judging sheet in all Project Books and Scrap Books prior to next level of judging.

### **Hard and Soft Crafts**

- To be decided in consultation with the State International Officer and Chair of State Handcraft and Cultural Committee.

### **International Tea Towel Competitions**

- Painted Tea Towel is to be decorated with paint only, including printed border (if applicable) without any changes or additions.
- Creative Tea Towel is to be decorated using any medium, including printed border (if applicable), minimum paint is to be used, without any changes or additions.
- Member/Branch and Division names are to be printed clearly on a fabric label and securely pinned to back of each Tea Towel entry.

### **General**

At all levels of the competition, in any section, there will only be one winner.

Prizes may be given in each section at all levels of judging.

First, Second, Third, Highly Commended Certificates may also be awarded at all levels of judging.
