NOTES AND HINTS.

- 50 cents per entry
- All entries to be completed within the past 18 months.
- Pieces previously entered that has not placed cannot be re-entered.
- Unless otherwise stated: e.g., 'Baby's Outfit...': entry is a single item only: if entering a bonnet, booties are not included in this for judging. Socks are a pair, and that is how they are entered.
- Any entry can be either an item or garment, any pattern or style.
- Any Medium is just that: any medium: Wool: Wool Blend: Cotton: Synthetic: Bamboo: Banana fibre: plastic: any 'yarn' that can be either knitted or crocheted.
- Tea Cosies are always lined.
- Mercerised cotton, wool and wool blend entries should always have the reel tag attached to the entry.
- Name tags: about 5-6cms square: Name, Branch, and Division, written on the inside, preferably in pen. Folded in half, with either 'K' or 'C' and class number written on the outside in pen. This is pinned to the outside of entry, with a medium sized silver pin, as these are stronger than the small gold pins.
- If entering a cushion cover: DO NOT place a cushion insert in and close cover:
- TAILS: please ensure all ends are ended off well, with no 'bits/tails' left dangling. Ensure coloured ends are worked into coloured work.
- Coat hangers must have covering over metal hoop.
- Miss Marjorie Morrow Award' is an award chosen from entries by the Division Competition Judge, for the '*Best Entry in Wool or Wool Blend*'.

Prize money is forwarded on to the recipient from State Competition.

A list of all winners is posted at State Conference, and on the webpage the next week acknowledging those entrants who have won these awards and their Divisions sponsored by Mrs A. Roberts.
