



State Photography Competition – Conditions of Entry

1. The competition is open to all Queensland photographers and QCWA Members.
2. Photographs must be the original work of the entrant and taken in the last two (2) years. The photographs must not have placed in this competition during the last two (2) years.
3. The entrant at Branch, Division, Region or State levels of judging must not be a judge or steward for the photography competition.
4. Cropping, contrast levels, saturation and sharpness may be used. The use of computer editing programs (e.g. Photoshop, etc) may not be used.
5. Categories 1-10 and 12-14 may be:
 - up to 7 x 5" (12.7 x 17.8 cm)
 - mounted on A5 black cardboard (½ A4 size)
6. Category 11 entries must be:
 - 6 x 4" (15 x 10 cm)
 - mounted on 35 x 25 cm black cardboard, mounted vertically
7. Photographs must not have borders around them or visible dates or times on the front of the photograph.
8. Photographs must be centrally mounted on black cardboard using jack paper or double-sided tape. Glue and photo corners are not to be used.
9. Each photography must be accompanied by a completed [entry form](#).
10. If possible, please place a dot of velcro in each corner of the photograph to make displaying easier for judging.
11. Photographs should be packaged for transport in separate brown paper bags (such as sandwich bags).
12. Up to three (3) photos may be entered at the Branch level of judging in each section.
13. The entry fee is 50c per photograph presented for judging.
14. A [disclaimer form](#) is required for any photograph that contains image of a child or children. This should be placed in a small envelope and attached to the back of the photograph mounting.
