



## QCWA STATE PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – THE RULES

- [1] The contest is open to all Queensland Photographers and Q.C.W.A. Members.
- [2] Photos must be the original work of the entrant and taken in the last 2 years. They must not have gained a place in the competition in that time.
- [3] The entrant at Branch, Division, Region or State levels of judging must not be a judge or steward for the photography competition.
- [4] Cropping, contrast levels, saturation and sharpness may be used. Computer Photo Shopping is not to be used.
- [5] Categories 1-10 and 12-14 entries may be up to 7x5" [12.7x17.8 cm] mounted on a5 size black cardboard [1/2 of an A4 sheet]  
  
Category 11-entries must be 6x4" mounted on 1 piece of black cardboard 35x25 cm vertically.
- [6] Photos must not have borders around them or visible dates or times on the front of photo.
- [7] photos must be centrally mounted on the black cardboard backing using jack paper or double sided tape. Glue and photo corners are not to be used.
- [8] Please use one of the entry forms provided to state the entrant's details.
- [9] It makes it easier to display photos at each level of judging if they have a Velcro dot on each corner of the back of the cardboard.
- [10] Please when packaging photos for transport to judging it is recommended that you put each photo in a brown paper sandwich bag. This will protect your photo from sticking to other photos and from getting the Velcro dots stuck to a photo.
- [11] Up to 3 photos may be entered at the branch level of judging in each section.
- [12] The entry fee per photo is 50 cents.
- [13] A disclaimer slip is provided which need to be filled in and attached to the back of photos portraying children. This should be folded in a small envelope and attached to the back of the cardboard.
