



**Billie Maykin Memorial Bursaries** (each \$500 per annum) are offered annually to secondary or tertiary students who are academically able but because of financial circumstances, would otherwise not be able to complete a secondary or tertiary level educational course.

This bursary is to be administered by the Queensland Country Women's Association (QCWA) State Executive.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form
- Demonstrated need for financial support
- Academic transcript detailing results over the past three (3) years
- Three (3) current character references

The **Billie Maykin Memorial Bursary** is available for the duration of the secondary or tertiary educational course provided that the recipient:

- Maintains a satisfactory academic achievement; and
- Reapplies for a possible continuation of funding.

QCWA will arrange a presentation function for the bursary and recipients will be asked to attend. Family and friends are welcome to attend.

As part of the **Billie Maykin Memorial Bursary**, recipients may be asked to assist the Association by volunteering their time and skills to special events or projects.

Applications close on **31<sup>st</sup> January** annually.
