

## 07-FM-004 Ruth Fairfax Memorial Bursary Application Form

The Queensland Country Women's Association Ruth Fairfax Memorial Bursary (\$2,500) is offered annually to students under the age of 25 years and whose permanent address is the State of Queensland and has received an offer to enter a tertiary institution and intends to pursue a course with major rural content.

This bursary is to be administered by the Queensland Country Women's Association (QCWA) State Executive and both male and female students are encouraged to apply. Applicant may need to available for interview.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form
- Academic transcript that details your achievements
- Demonstrated need for financial support
- Three (3) current character references

50% of the bursary is to be awarded immediately upon selection, with the balance to be paid upon receipt of a favourable six-month academic report. The awardee is requested to submit a 12-monthly report on their progress and use of the bursary funds. The QCWA reserves the right to limit the period over which a bursary is granted to any one student.

QCWA will arrange a presentation function for the bursary and recipients will be asked to attend. Family and friends are welcome to attend.

As part of the **Ruth Fairfax Memorial Bursary**, recipients may be asked to assist the Association by volunteering their time and skills to special events or projects.

Applications close on 31st January annually.
